All entries must be secured with an open check or a signed credit card authorization form for back numbers to be released. Credit card customers a convenience fee of 3% of the total invoice will be added to all invoices being paid with a credit card.

Any check returned by the bank for any reason, or any credit card that is disputed or declined will be charged a \$50 fee or 10% of the amount of the payment, whichever is greater. All declined payments must be replaced by certified funds.

No exhibitor will be permitted to participate at the show while a prior indebtedness is outstanding.

Please check out by the end of the show.

NON SHOWING FEE:

Any horse on the ground must be entered in classes or pay a \$150 non showing fee. An entry blank must be on file for every horse on the grounds and pay the non refundable office fee.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be credited to show bills and paid within 30 days following the competition. Prize money and refunds will be made payable to the owner of the horse unless otherwise indicated on the entry form. A valid SS # or Tax ID is required for all payments. Prize money will be forfeited for exhibitors who do not wish to provide this information.

After December 31 any unclaimed prize money (uncashed checks) will be considered a donation to the Texas Children's Hospital.

REFUNDS AND SCRATCHES

No stall fees will be refunded after the close of entries.

Entry fees, less a \$50 scratch fee will be refunded once a certificate of illness or injury to horse or rider is presented to the show office prior to the start of the show. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to officially scratch in any classes they do no plan to participate in at the show office. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse entered becomes injured or ill prior to the start of the class(es) entered. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian.

0 STALLS

Stalls for the Pin Oak Charity Horse Show will be available for \$175. Stalls are permanent or temporary under a tent 12' x 12' or 10' x 10' with doors. All horses must have a stall. Management may limit tack stalls if necessary. Exhibitors are responsible for any damage made to a stall. Charges for damage to any stall will be billed to the exhibitor by GSEC. Damage to any stall panel will incur a \$100 fee per panel. Dismantling or altering stalls will incur a \$50 fee per panel for re installment by GSEC. Pin Oak Charity Horse Show is not responsible for any additional housing or security needs for stalls or any other special needs horses. The owners are responsible for any additional modifications and to supply the materials and labor needed to secure their stalls for their horses safety and the safety of the horses around them.

Stall requests must be accompanied by stall fees and/or an open check/credit card authorization form. Stalls are assigned on a first come basic.



BEDDING/FEED

Shavings will be available for purchase on the grounds from 8am –5pm daily. It is a facility policy that no outside shavings or bedding is permitted. A fine of \$100 per stall will be assessed to those violating this policy

All feed and bedding orders will be billed through the show office. Trainers wishing to do "splits" must provide that information to the show office by Friday at 12:00pm.

DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS

Current USEF rules and regulations regarding D & M will be enforced. Sharps and medical waste must be disposed of in sharps containers placed around the barns. All competitors are asked to comply with the USEF Testing Veterinarian in a courteous and efficient manner. Please note that sharps containers MUST be used as provided or penalties will occur.

All showing horses will be invoiced the USEF D & M Fee of \$23.

FOOTING AND ARENA/RING DIMENSIONS

Footing is a priority; rings may be closed to schooling during inclement weather and/or for maintenance at any time during the show at management's discretion.

Main Indoor Arena—150' x 290' ESI Footing Wheless (East) Indoor Arena 125' x 250' Sandy Loam Footing

FIRE/ELECTRICAL REGULATIONS

Barn areas must be kept free of motor vehicles. Roping off or blocking aisles in barn areas is prohibited. Designated fire lanes must be kept clear. Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas will be towed and subject to recovery of the towing fee from the owner. All extension cords must be Underwriters' Laboratory approved for outdoor use. Heavy extension cords are recommended. These rules are for the protection of the exhibitor, his livestock, fellow exhibitors and the public. The use of electric open flame or space heaters is prohibited. Cooking or any heat/flame food preparation is not allowed in the barn area.

RV HOOK UPS

Camper spaces are available for \$300 per week in the old section; \$350 per week in the Premier section. One pump out per week is included. Camper pump outs will be done on Saturday. Anyone needing additional pumps out will incur additional charges. To reserve your RV Space please complete the RV Camper Registration Form and return it to the show secretary.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

All horse health paperwork must be pre copied and left at the front gate upon arrival. Please check www.gswec.com and www.pinoak.org for additional equine health requirements

Health Certificates—A Health Certificate within 21 days of arrival is required upon arrival at check in. This may change at the discretion of the management

Coggins—Texas law requires that each horse has a negative EIA certificate dated within one year. A negative EIA (Coggins Test) must accompany each horse when it enters the grounds. Horses will not be permitted on the grounds without documentation.

Vaccinations—All horses on the grounds must comply with and provide proof of vaccinations per USEF GR 844. Horses will not be permitted on the grounds without documentation.

RESPONSIBILITY

Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Great Southwest Equestrian Center LP, The Pin Oak Charity Horse Show, Kent Moeller or their officers, respective directors, agents, show management, employees or representatives against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including responsable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its conditions of this agreement, or contractors, agents, premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Great Southwest Equestrian Center LP, The Pin Oak Charity Horse Show, Kent Moeller, or their officers, respective directors, agents, show management, employees or representatives by reason of any such claim.

Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceedings by counsel acceptable to Great Southwest Equestrian Center LP or The Pin Oak Charity Horse Show. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and the Great Southwest Equestrian Center LP is not responsible for accidents, loss, fire or theft.

PETS

All pets on the show grounds must be on leashes at ALL times and must not be tied in the aisles in the barns. This will be enforced. Your cooperation is appreciated for the benefit of exhibitors and spectators. Pursuant to GR1301. A \$100 loose pet fee (donated to a local charity) will be collected for all animals found without a leash.





QUESTIONS, DISPUTES AND PROTESTS

All protests and questions not covered by these rules shall be decided and interpreted by the Competition Committee, whose decision shall be final. Disputes should be presented to the Show Manager prior to filing a formal protest under the provisions of the USEF Chapter VI. A protest must be in writing and may be made to the Competition Committee by any exhibitor, agent, trainer or parent of a Jr. Exhibitor for any violation of USEF Rules.

RIBBONS/TROPHIES

A trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.

AMATEUR CERTIFICATION

Every person who has reached his 18th birthday (as of December 1 of the previous year) and competes in classes restricted to amateurs under USEF rules must posses current USEF Amateur Certification. Riders must be members of USEF to apply for amateur certification. USEF GR 1307

UPDATED USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS IMPORTANT

Extraordinary Rule Change to GR 202.1

Non member participants in the role of riders, drivers, handlers, vaulters, lungers, owners, lessees and agents MUST pay a show pass fee. COMPETITIONS CANNOT ACCEPT PAYMENT FOR A SHOW PASS FEE FROM EXHIBITORS. SHOW PASS FEES CAN ONLY BE MADE ONLINE ON THE USEF WEB SITE BY EXHIBITORS. Non members in the above roles are limited to obtaining no more than 1 (one) show pass per competition year.

To be eligible to participate at Federation Licensed Competitions, all persons acting as coaches or trainers, and legal guardians signing entry blanks as coaches or trainers on behalf of their minors MUST be Senior Members in good standing. Paper applications will no longer be available in 2024. Please make sure all USEF Memberships are current before you check in at the show office

Safe Sport Requirements—Safe Sport Training must be completed prior to the first day of competition.

CREDENTIALS

No number will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. All exhibitors must provide proof of current memberships and are encouraged to submit copies with their entries. All horses must be recorded in accordance to the rules of USEF, ASHA, AHHS, and ARHPA. Measurement cards must be presented for all classes restricted by size of horse/pony. Please check with the office for times if your horse/pony needs to be measured.

A copy of registration papers from ASHA, AHHS or ARHPA must be presented to the horse show office before numbers my be released.

All entry blanks must be signed in provided spaces by owner, trainer, rider, driver, coach or handler. Anyone under the USEF show age of 18, must have the signature of a parent or guardian on the entry blank. It is the responsibility of the person making the entry to execute properly and complete all the necessary information pertaining to each entry made in accordance with the rules of USEF.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of a personal electronic transport device, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.





USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

SAFE SPORT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org



Princess-loving patient overpowers cancer





In order to compete all horses must be registered with the American Saddlebred Registry or the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation. They must be entered in their full registered names with the registration numbers and under the names of the owner(s) of record with the ASR or the CLRC. A copy of the registration papers showing proof or ownership, or a copy of the registration papers with a Certificate of Eligibility to Show issued by the American Saddlebred Registry must be submitted with the entry or presented to the competition office before competition numbers will be released; competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. USEF SB 101.1. Exception: Horses shown in any USEF Regular Competition prior to December 31, 1979 and Saddlebred type ponies.

Stake or Championship Classes:

To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in one other class in their respective section. *Five Gaited and Three Gaited Sections—a horse qualified in an open class can only show back in the Open Championship. UPHA Classics require a nominating fee and membership to UPHA; which may be paid at the show.



ACADEMY CLASSES UNRATED



The Lesson Horse: Open only to horses or ponies used in a lesson program. Horses may cross enter in performance classes at the same show. Academy Performance class shall be judged on the rider's horsemanship and the overall picture of the rider and horse. Academy Equitation classes shall be judged on Basic Equitation skills. English tack is to be used, unless otherwise specified. Full, snaffle or pelham bridles may be used.

The Academy Rider: Open to students enrolled in a lesson program. An academy Rider may cross enter into another division, but not at the same show, with the exception of driving classes. Headers are allowed in all Academy classes if needed for safety. Once a rider has shown in a canter class—of any breed—they may not return to the Walk/Trot Section. Age of riders is determined by the age as of December 1 of the previous year, per USEF Rules.

Braiding and hoof blackening is optional.

Acceptable attire- dark slacks or jods, boots or footwear with heels, collared shirt with vest or sweater, man's tie, derbies or other traditional headgear is optional. No riding suits or day coats are allowed. Neatness of attire and cleanliness of tack will be judged.

Academy Maiden Classes—for riders who have never won a blue ribbon in a walk/trot/canter class

Academy Limit Classes—for riders who have won less than six blue ribbons in walk/trot/canter classes. Maiden riders qualify.

Academy Advanced Classes—for riders who have won six or more blue ribbons AND have competed in the Academy Walk/Trot/Canter division for at least 2 years. All blue ribbons won in the last two years in the Walk/Trot/Canter classes, in any division, count toward your level eligibility. Blue ribbons won in one horse classes do not count. Any rider wishing to move up to the advanced level may do so, but may not return to the limit level



From San Antonio: Take I 10 East and exit Mason Road, Exit 745. Go right (South) for three miles and the Center is on the left.


