THE PIN OAK CHARITY **HORSE SHOW**

Beyond the crowning of new champions, the showcasing of top-caliber equestrian sport and the coming together of old friends and competitors lies a greater purpose to the Pin Oak Charity Horse Show. For more than 75 years, the desire to give backhas remained the heart and soulof the horse show.

In 1947, the Pin Oak Charity Horse Show made the organization's very first donation to Texas Children's Hospital, aiding in the planning and building of the now renowned institution. 



All entries must be secured with an open check or signed credit card authorization for back numbers to be released from the show office. Credit Card Customers - a convenience fee of three (3) percent of the total invoice will be added to all invoices being paid with a credit card. Any check returned by the bank for any reason, or any credit card that is disputed or declined will be charged a \$75 fee or 10% of the amount of the payment, whichever is greater. All declined payments must be replaced by certified funds.

No exhibitor will be permitted to participate at the show while a prior indebtedness is outstanding.

Exhibitors must check out their account each week. Any exhibitor that fails to check themselves out, will be invoiced an additional \$60 by the show. No exhibitor with an outstanding bill from the previous week will be permitted to pick up numbers.

NON SHOWING FEE

Any horse on the ground for any showing week must be entered in classes or pay the \$150 non showing fee. An entry blank must be on file for EVERY horse on the grounds and pay the non-refundable office fee.

SHOWN NOT ENTERED

All class entries must be done in the show office prior to the start of the first round. Any horse participating in a class fore which they were not entered, will be subject to double the entry fee for the class.

NIGHT WATCH

All horses occupying a stall, showing and non showing, will be required to pay a show night watch fee of \$25 per show. This service is NOT optional.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be credited to show bills and paid within 30 days following the conclusion of the show via check. Prize money and refunds will be made payable to the owner of the horse unless otherwise indicated in writing to the show office. A valid SSN or Tax ID information is required for all payments. A FORM W9 is required to be presented for all exhibitors for any prize money to be credited. *Please note, tax identification numbers are required to pay out horse show prize money.

Prize money will be forfeited for exhibitors who do not wish to provide this information.

After December 31 any unclaimed prize money (uncashed checks) will be considered a donation to the Texas Children's Hospital.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Foreign exhibitors are advised that the US Internal Revenue Service requires sporting events to withhold 30% of the prize money won in the United States. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a US Social Security number and be asked to complete FORM W8-BEN prior to any prize money being paid.

REFUNDS AND SCRATCHES

No stall fees will be refunded after the close of entries.

Entry fees, less a \$75 scratch fee will be refunded once a certificate of illness or injury to horse or rider is presented to the show office before the start of each show. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to officially scratch entries in any classes they do not plan to participate in writing in the show office. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes that they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the start of the class(es) entered. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian.

STALLS

Stalls for Pin Oak Charity Horse shows will be available for \$350. Stalls are permanent or temporary under tent on dirt, 12' x 12' and 10' x 10' with doors. All horses must show out of a stall. Exception, breeding/in hand horses may purchase a single night stall for \$100. Horses are not permitted to share stalls, unless all horses are owned by members of the same family. Management may limit tack stalls if necessary. Exhibitors are responsible for any damage made to a stall. Charges for damage to any stall will be billed to the exhibitor by GSEC. Damage to any stall panel will incur a \$100 fee per panel. Pin Oak Charity Horse Show is not responsible for any additional housing or security needs for stallions or any other special needs horses. The owners are responsible for any additional modifications and to supply the materials and labor needed to secure their stalls for their horses safety and the horses around them.

Stall requests must be accompanied by stall fees or an open check/ credit card authorization. form. Stalls are assigned on a first come basis.

JUMP ORDERS

A random jump order will be used for all classes in the Main Arena. All classes offering \$5,000 or more will have an drawn order.

BEDDING/FEED

Shavings will be available for purchase on grounds from 8am -5pm daily. It is facility policy that no outside shavings or bedding is permitted. A fine of \$100 per stall will be assessed to those violating this policy.

All feed and bedding ordered will be billed through the horse show office. Trainers wishing to do "splits" must provide that information to the show office by the posted weekly deadline. Any splits submitted after the weekly deadline, may be done with an additional split fee. No splits will be done on check out day, no exceptions!

DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS

Current USEF rules and regulations regarding D & M will be enforced. Sharps and medical waste must be disposed of in sharps containers placed around the barns. All competitors are asked to comply with the USEF Testing Veterinarians in a courteous and efficient manner. Please note that sharps containers MUST be used as provided or penalties will occur. (GR1210.4)

All showing horses will be invoiced the USEF D & M and USEF Fee of \$23. USHJA fee of \$10 will be assessed to every showing entry.

COURSES

Courses will be posted a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the start of each class. At management's discretion, a dotted line may be put into effect to restrict the size of the courtesy circle in hunter classes.

ATTIRE

Jumper Proper Attire (Jackets) is required for all classes in the Main Arena unless otherwise noted. Jumper Formal Attire is required for all Jumper Class offering \$10,000 or more.

FOOTING AND ARENA DIMENSIONS

Footing is a priority; rings may be closed to schooling during inclement weather and/or for maintenance at any time during the show at management's discretion.

FIRE/ELECTRICAL REGULATIONS

Barn areas must be kept free of motor vehicles. Roping off or blocking of aisles in barn areas is prohibited. Designated fire lanes must be kept clear. Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas will be towed and subject to recovery of the towing fee from the owner. All extension cords must be Underwriters Laboratory approved for outdoor use. Heavy extension cords are recommended. These rules are for the protection of the exhibitor, his livestock, fellow exhibitors and the public. The use of electric, open flame or space heaters is prohibited. Cooking or any heat/flame food preparation is not allowed in the barn area.

RV HOOKUPS

Camper spaces are available for \$300 per week in the old section; \$350 per week in the Premier section. One pump out per week is included. Camper pump outs will be done on Saturday of each week. Anyone needing additional pump outs WILL incur additional charges. To reserve your RV space a form of payment must be provided in advance. Please fill out a stall, shavings and RV Reservation Form or contact the Pin Oak Charity Horse Show office (281-578-7669). A late fee of \$50 will be assessed for any reservation that is submitted after 3/8/2025. Priority will be given to sponsors/exhibitors staying all three weeks. Sponsors receive priority if received by 3/1/2025. RV spaces sell out every year. Online reservations WILL NOT be accepted after 3/8/2025.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

All horse health paperwork must be precopied and left at the front gate upon arrival.Please continually check www.gswec.com and www.pinoak.org for any additional equine health requirements.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES

A health certificate within 21 days of arrival is required upon arrival at the check in point. This may change at the discretion of management.

COGGINS REGULATIONS

Texas law requires that each horse has a negative EIA certificate dates within in one year. A negative EIA (Coggins Test) must accompany each horse when it enters the grounds. Horses will not be permitted on the grounds without documentation.

VACCINATIONS

All horses on the grounds must comply with and provide proof of vaccinations per USEF GR845. Horses will not be permitted on the grounds without documentation.

RESPONSIBILITY

Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to he following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Great Southwest Equestrian Center LP, The Pin Oak Charity Horse Show, Oliver Kennedy or their officers, respective directors, agents, show management, employees or representatives against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its conditions of this agreement, or contractors, agents, premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Great Southwest Equestrian Center LP, The Pin Oak Charity Horse Show, Oliver Kennedy or their officers, respective directors, agents, show management, employees or representatives by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by counsel acceptable to Great Southwest Equestrian Center LP or The Pin Oak Charity Horse Show. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property, and the Great Southwest Equestrian Center LP is not responsible for accidents, fire or theft.

UNDER TEXAS LAW (CHAPTER 87, CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE), A FARM ANIMAL PROFESSIONAL OR FARM OWNER OR LESSEE IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN FARM ANIMAL ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING AN EMPLOYEE OR INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF FARM ANIMAL ACTIVITIES.

PETS

All pets on the Show Grounds must be on leashes at ALL times and must not be tied in the aisles in the barns. This will be enforced. Your cooperation will be appreciated for the benefit of exhibitors and spectators. Pursuant to USEF GR301. A \$100 Loose Pet Fee (donated to a local charity) will be collected for all animals found without a leash.

THJA

No points will be counted toward THJA annual awards until membership dues have been paid and horses have been recorded with THJA. Join THJA Online at www.thja.org.

THJA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

THJA members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at competitions recognized by THJA. A person/horse may register with the THJA at a recognized horse show as long as the application(s) and payment accompanies the official horse show results. Registrations may also be completed online with a credit card at the THJA web site before the end of the show. All riders and trainers, in addition to owners of THJA registered horses must be members of THJA for the points to count.

PIN OAK CHARITY HORSE SHOW (ONE) (TWO) AND (THREE) are operated in accordance with current rules of the Texas Hunter & Jumper Association by which it is recognized and rated: "A" in Performance Hunter 3'3" & 3'6", Green 3', 3'3", 3'6" & 3'9" Hunter, Amateur Owner, Green Pony, Pony, Children's Pony, Junior, Short, Medium & Long Stirrup HunterChildren's and Adult Amateur Hunter, Modified Children's and Modified Adult Hunters and Jr/AO Jumper, Children's Jumper, Adult Amateur Jumper. Points for placings in Hunter Breeding, Junior, Pony, Children or Adult Equitation classes, Opportunity Cross Rails & Opportunity Walk/Trot Hunters will be credited in accordance with the rules of the THJA.

CREDENTIALS

No number will be release until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. All exhibitors must provide proof of current memberships. Anyone not presenting current membership credentials (USHJA) will be charged a show pass fee of \$30 per person. All Owners, riders, trainers must provide proof of current USEF Membership to pick up their number. All horses must be recorded with USEF and USHJA. Annual or Life recordings may be required for specific classes. Measurement cards required for all pony hunter, green pony hunter, children's pony hunter and small junior hunter classes. Only one USEF show pass fee per year will be granted by USEF and must be paid on their website.

All entry blanks must be signed in provided spaces by Owner, Trainer, Rider, Driver, Coach or Handler. Anyone under the USEF Show age of 18 must have the signature of a parent or guardian on the entry blank. It is the responsibility of the person making the entry to execute properly and complete all necessary information pertaining to each entry made in accordance with the rules of USEF. Every Owner, Rider, Trainer, Coach must sign a waiver online.

AMATEUR CERTIFICATION

Every person who has reached his 18th birthday (as of Dec 1 of the previous year) and competes in classes restricted to amateurs under USEF rules must possess current USEF amateur certification. Riders must be a member of USEF to apply for amateur certification. USEF GR1307

RIBBONS/TROPHIES/CHAMPIONSHIPS

All hunter classes will receive a trophy and eight ribbons unless otherwise noted. All equitation classes will received a trophy and eight ribbons unless otherwise noted. All jumper classes will receive a trophy and eight ribbons unless otherwise noted. Each hunter and jumper section will receive a champion and reserve award based on points unless otherwise noted. Hunter Championship will be rendered per USEF Rules. Jumper Championships will be rendered using the Bonus Point system. Bonus points will be applied to one class per section (see section for specific class). Ties in Jumper Championships will be broken by the highest place horse in the bonus class.

SCHOOLING

There will be limited schooling at times to be posted in Show Office. Ticketed paid schooling, if time permits, may be available.

QUESTIONS, DISPUTES & PROTESTS

All protests and questions not covered by these rules shall be decided and interpreted by the Competition Committee, whose decision shall be final. Disputes should be presented to the Show Manager prior to filing a formal protest under the provisions of USEF Chapter VI. A protest must be in writing and may be made to the Competition Committee by and exhibitor, agent, trainer or parent of a Jr. Exhibitor for any violation of USEF Rules.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/ legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Federation Entry Agreement:

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Pin Oak Horse Show (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media

or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the Stateof New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.1.

If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber, I acknowledge that I will be enrolled for no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew in USEF's sole discretion. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. USEF may in its sole discretion, at any time, terminate my USEF Fan status.

SAFE SPORT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. 





Round Two: Handy Hunter Course - there will be a minimum of eight obstacles. Fences set at 3', with four option fences set at 3'5". Judged on performance, hunter pace and jumping style, quality and substance, movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. After the score is given, one point will be added for each high option fences jumped without major fault (maximum of four points).

The top 12 horses from the first round will return in reverse order of score for the second round; lowest score returning first.

Each class may have the option of having either one (1) or two (2) panels of judges. Each panel will consist of two (2) judges sitting together. Tradition to be emphasized in the attire of both the riders and the horses. Horse will show in traditional hunter tack, including snaffles, pelhams, double bridles & both running and standing martingales.

For Derbies with \$49,999 or less in prize money, a minimum of two (2) R-licensed judges are required. Judges will be seated separately, giving an individual score for both phases. The scores from each judge will be added together for the total score.

Round One: Hunter Classic Course - to be shown over a hunter classic type course consisting of a minimum of 10 fences/obstacles that simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and a variety of derby jumps will be used. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality and substance, movement and brilliance.

Horses are to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of their first round.

Ties in the first round will remain tied. The top 12 horses after the first round, including ties, will return for the second round.

Round Two: - Handy Hunter Course - to be shown over a minimum of eight obstacles and will include a minimum of three required "handy options." To be judges on style, brilliance and handiness.

All ties for overall first place may compete in a Jump Off Round at the discretion of the owners and riders. If a tie occurs after the Jump Off Round, OR if both exhibitors agree NOT to jump off, the exhibitors will be named co-winners, will evenly split the prize money. Tied entrants must determine the distribution of awards amongst themselves. If one of the tied exhibitors declines to jump off, that exhibitor must sign a forfeiture agreement which will be provided to them at the time of the jump off. All other placings will remain tied.

Horses may not compete in both the USHJA National and International Derbies at the same show.

All jumper declarations are due by 4 p.m. the day prior to the class, unless otherwise noted. Nomination fee of \$200 is required for those classes listed in the nominated jumper section. Horses will only pay one nominating fee regardless of cross entry into money classes. Championships will be awarded in jumper sections that offer three or more classes not held at Table II. Champion and Reserve will be determined using the USEF bonus point system. Bonus Points will apply to the last class or highest money class. In the event of a tie for Champion or Reserve the bonus class placing (or participation) will break all ties. Riders should be properly attired. Proper Jumper Attire, jackets, are required for all classes in the Main Arena. Standard Jumper Attire is permitted for classes in other rings. It is the exhibitors responsibility to familiarize themselves with all pertinent current USEF rules and regulations for the Jumper division and jumper schooling areas. A 45 second count down clock will be used. Poling or offsets will not be permitted on the grounds. Ties for placing other than first place will be separated by time. Time allowed in accordance with USEF JP 129.

Not all classes are offered every week, please refer to time schedule for classes offered and for all jumper tables.

HORSE SHOW ISSUED number card must be worn on rider's back or on the saddle pad so that it is visible to the paddock master.
